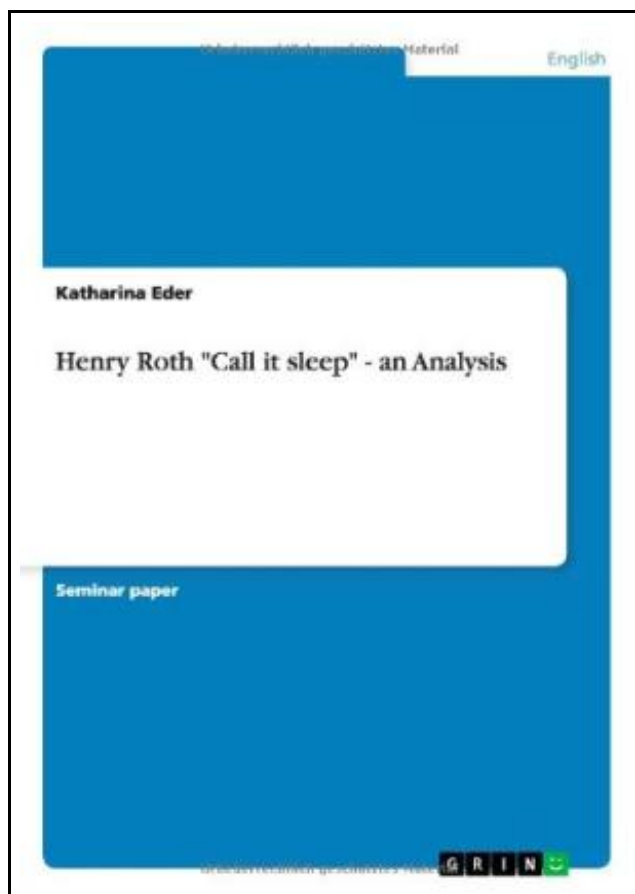

The book tells us about David Schearl, child of Jewish immigrants in the first decades of the 19th century. Similarities between the authors biography and Davids life are quite obvious. This paper will give a short overview of the authors life and point out a few similarities with the book. After a brief abstract of the novels content the focus will be on identity created through language and the Jewish origin of the character. Identity is a very important motif in Roths novel and it is influenced by the history of Jewish immigrants in New Yorks Lower East Side, as well as by the urban experiences of the character. David searches for his own identity within and outside of his own community. In the following parts Roths technique will be explained by Cohns theory of psycho-narration, with a focus on the modernist climax in the penultimate chapter. The paper ends in the conclusion that Roths novel is about the search of identity, depicted through a variety of methods. This item ships from multiple locations.
