Sir: - Under the provisions of Chapter 47, Public Laws of North Carolina, Acts of 1913, I have the honor to submit the report of the Military Department for the year ending December 31, 1915. General Condition of the National Guard The condition of the National Guard at this time is very satisfactory, as is shown by Table 2 on page 10. This table is a compilation of the data contained in the reports of the Federal Officers detailed under section 14 of the amended Militia Laws to inspect the organized militia. It will be noted that this table shows marked improvement in all lines over previous reports, with the exception of the physical examination of the enlisted personnel. It has been a physical impossibility to comply strictly with the requirements of the War Department in this particular, due to the fact that no funds have been provided by either...
