The object of this institution is set forth in the following constitution of the Hall of Fame approved by the university in March, 1900: Constitution of the Hall of Fame. A gift of one hundred thousand dollars is accepted by New York University under the following conditions: The money is to be used for building a colonnade five hundred feet in length, at University Heights, looking toward the Palisades and the Harlem and Hudson river valleys. The exclusive use of the colonnade is to serve as The Hall of...
